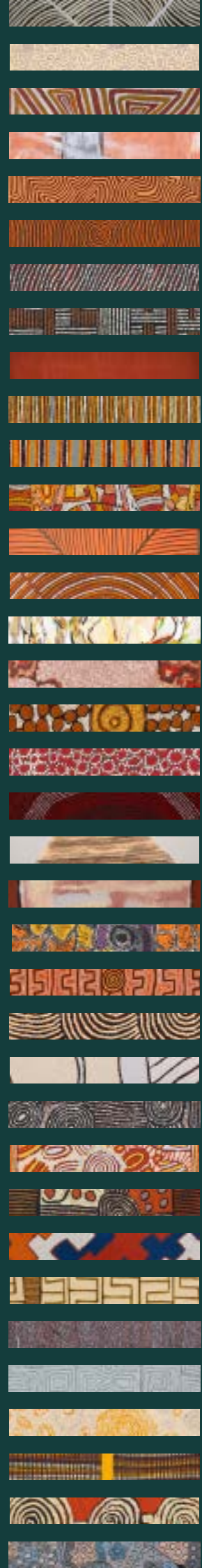

Utopia Celebrates Country

This exhibition is presented in conjunction with one of Australia's most respected contemporary art galleries, Utopia Art Sydney, renowned for its long-standing commitment to both Indigenous and non-Indigenous Australian artists. The exhibition reflects on 'Country' through the creations of both Indigenous and non-Indigenous artists, displayed equally and side by side.

Country is the idea of home, both physically and in our memories. It is how we perceive the landscape, both from experience and imagination. Australians see ourselves as having strong links to the land - the bush and the outback. Indigenous artists use their layered understanding of their Country in creating their paintings.

Utopia Art Sydney

Utopia Art Sydney is a highly regarded and established gallery in Sydney committed to the representation of a small group of Australian artists. These include leading members of Papunya Tula Artists, Gloria Petyarre from Utopia and non-Indigenous artists from Sydney, Melbourne and Canberra. Their reputation as one of the leading contemporary art galleries owes much to the fact that all our artists are represented equally.

Utopia Art Sydney has exhibited Indigenous and non-Indigenous artists in a contemporary context since 1988. This has led to the emergence of Aboriginal artists like Emily Kame Kngwarreye into the mainstream of Australian art.

Papunya Tula Artists

In 1971 a group of Aboriginal artists from the government settlement at Papunya began painting traditional designs using acrylic paints and small boards.

This was the beginning of the Western Desert art movement that has become one of Australia's most recognisable art forms and which led to the formation of the first Indigenous arts businesses, Papunya Tula Artists cooperative, in 1972, based in Papunya in the Northern Territory, and which is entirely owned and directed by Indigenous people from the Western Desert, predominantly of the Luritja/Pintupi language groups.

The work of the Papunya Tula Artists is highly regarded around the world. The unmistakable and powerful style of the work has resulted in the Papunya Tula artists being represented in most public galleries, major museums, institutions and many large private collections within Australia as well as overseas.

The aim of the company is to promote individual artists, provide economic development for the communities to which they belong, and assist in the maintenance of a rich cultural heritage.
